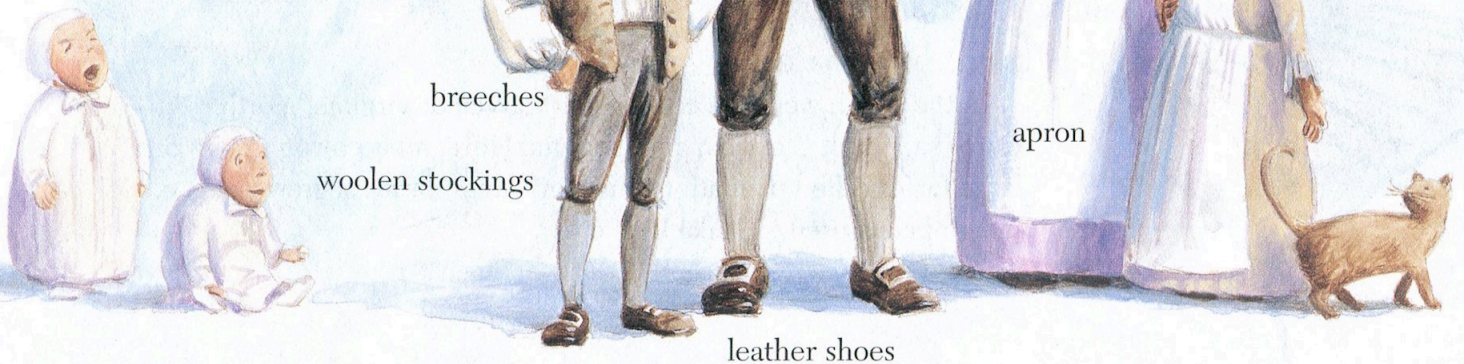


## *What did colonial people look like?*

Most people made their own clothes at home. Boys wore the same kind of clothes as grown men. Girls dressed like women.

Both boys and girls wore a kind of dress — called a frock — until they were four or five years old.
